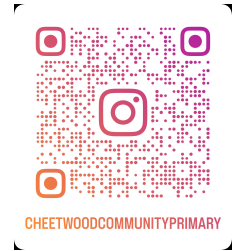

* Funded home upgrades available for families across Manchester

Manchester City Council are working alongside Improveasy to deliver ECO Flex across Manchester. ECO Flex is a government-mandated programme obligating energy companies to fund home improvements for qualifying households. Eligible households include those within LSOA postcodes, recipients of free school meals, and those with a combined income of £31,000 or less, among other criteria. The purpose of ECO Flex is to improve energy efficiency and reduce heating costs.
